Not the largest orchestra in the world, but one that has been the basis over many years for the recording of my film-scores, music for many television series, and settings of verse and narrative for the radio.

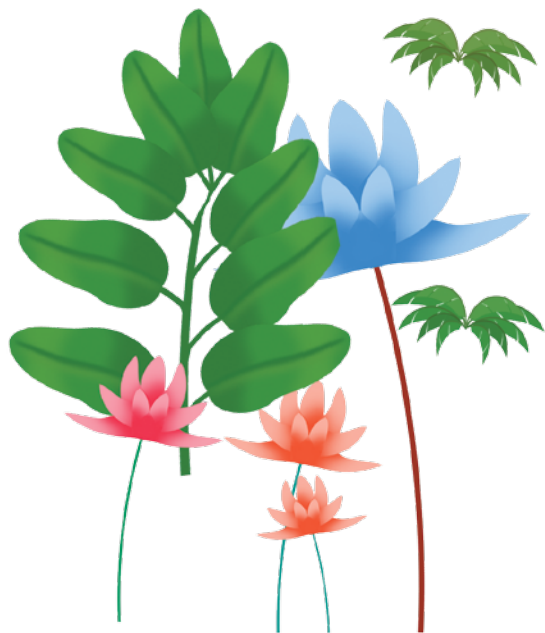

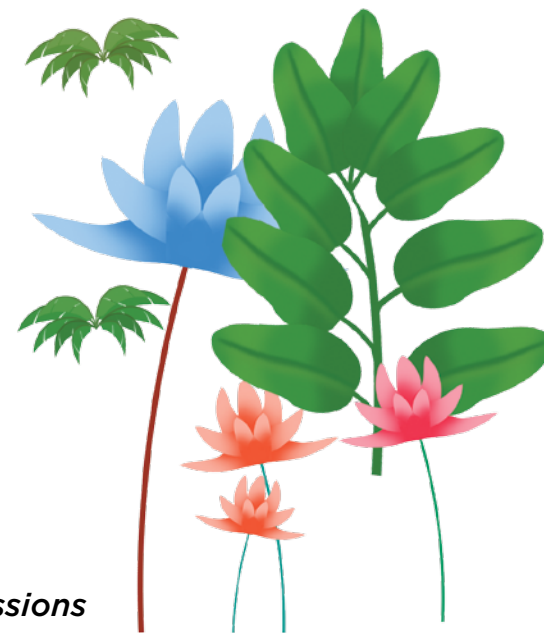
