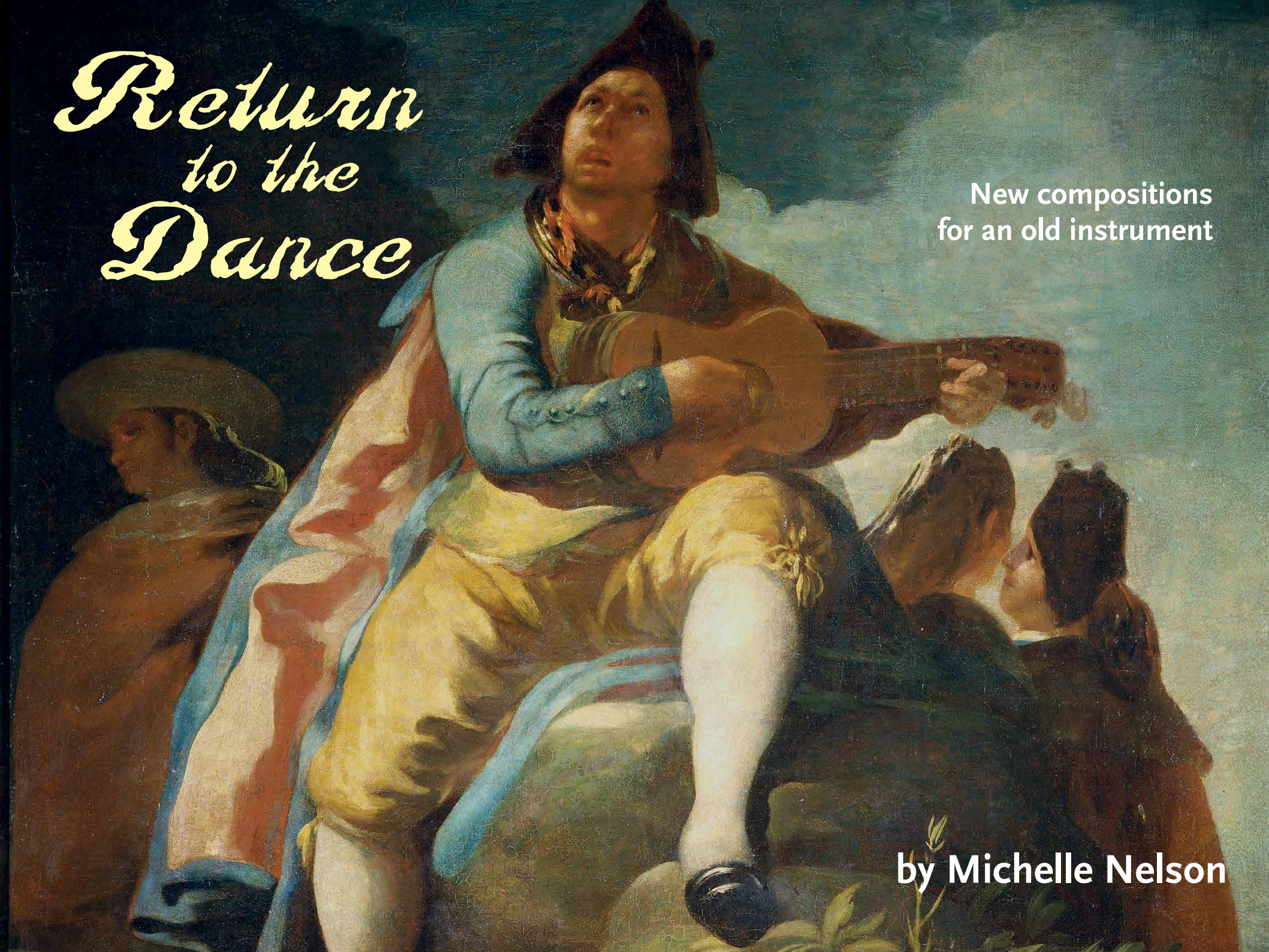

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Return to the Dance

The Guitarist's Bach

A new work for EADGBE guitar in the style of JS Bach's Lute Suites. Constructed around three short phrases from those revered works, this new suite won the 2013 Composition prize Homage to JS Bach sponsored by the Australian Bach Society & the Classical Guitar Society of Victoria.

Ice Crystals

Inspired by the brilliant inner world of ice. Exploring space and time through harmony, some of it slow-moving, some as rapid bursts of colour.

Platypus Rag

Ragtime for two related instruments; Guitar and Taropatch; a double-strung Ukelele descended from the small Portuguese guitars introduced to Hawaii, via South America in the 19th Century. Taropatch: Lesley Gentilin.

Dances for the New World

New Volta; a dance in common time with a distinct jump on the 1st beat. Rock 'n Rolan (Hommage à Marc Bolan); ode to a 1970's Rock hero. Mirage; an ecstatic dance featuring the Lydian #4th; (very Jimmy P.)

Return to the Dance IV

Trance-dance, electro-acoustic treatment of Return to the Dance I. Classical Guitar, Yamaha SLG200N (silent guitar), Moog Filter and various other effects. Sound engineer: Richie Brain.
