

The accompanying poem, ‘Regret’, is by Arjun von Caemmerer. It can be seen from page 4 of this digital booklet, and also on YouTube. The poem selectively catalogs/arranges a small sample of precarious Australian flora and fauna, including some species now lost altogether, and some whose grip on survival appears increasingly tenuous in the face of accelerating climate change.

Piano Sonata #5 “Greta”

Concerto in no need of an orchestra

One of the most extraordinary developments in recent years has been the emergence of a young spokesperson for the coming generations, those who will have to deal with the climate catastrophe caused by humans. Her name is Greta Thunberg and her story is well-known. I hope that the current crop of political liars and climate catastrophe deniers is speedily replaced by the likes of Greta, who see the state of the planet clearly and are unafraid to act, even to the extent of putting their own lives and dreams on hold. This sonata is an atonement from my generation to Greta’s, hence the dedication to my two children, and is formed through a sequence of hermeneutic windows

based on the letters of her first name.

The rhetorical nature of the piece suggests a concerto, but in this case the soloist is truly alone, courageously presenting their arguments in the face of indifference, ridicule and hatred. The work is in five sections, for each letter of the name “Greta”. Each section modulates the GRETA row according to each of the key centres of the five letters. Therefore the work is like a gigantic so-called “interrupted” cadence. The harmonic character of the piece can best be described as pan-tonal, by which is meant it embraces a large variety of compositional languages and interpretations, even to the extent of introducing electric keyboard to the instrumentation if desired. The five-note row provides coherence across these disparate elements,

and in this way is an analogy of the cross-cultural/cross-species range and influence of Greta Thunberg’s crusade.

The possibility of using an electric keyboard, hopefully deriving power from a renewable source, frees the Sonata/Concerto from the domain of the concert grand piano with its connotations of upper class luxury and collusion with conservatism. This versatility gives the work a further connection to the protean vision of its namesake. The alternative instrumentation is played as follows: **6** part 1 electric organ, **7** part 2 fender rhodes, **8** part 3 electric harpsichord, **9** part 4 electric bass, **10** part 5 electric piano.

(A REGRET)

Regret (A Regret) is written as a textual accompaniment for Michael Kieran Harvey's **Piano Sonata #5, 'Greta'** (2020).

A few short **Letters of Introduction** precede the open-ended scroll of imperilled Australian flora and fauna. These are drawn from Australia's Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation categories: 'extinct', 'extinct in the wild', 'critically endangered', 'endangered', 'vulnerable', and 'conservation dependent'. The list concludes with **A Ruminations** on the endangered Tasmanian devil, afflicted with facial tumour disease.

This visual roll call of the departed and departing is necessarily a fraction of a fraction of a fraction, and can be unfurled synchronously with the five musical movements of the Sonata.

It may, using the GRETA template, be freely adopted and adapted for any other geographical area.
